§94909 - Minimum Requirements for School Catalog.	<p>(a) Except as provided in subdivision (d), prior to enrollment, an institution shall provide a prospective student, either in writing or electronically, with a school catalog containing, at a minimum, all of the following:</p> <p>(7) Information regarding the faculty and their qualifications.</p> <p>The institution’s catalog failed to include information regarding the faculty and their qualifications.</p> <p>To remedy the violation, the institution shall update their catalog to include information about their instructors and their qualifications. A copy of the revised catalog shall be submitted with the last page of this document by the due date listed below.</p>



