I reviewed the catalog and found it to be incomplete and missing several required statements, disclosures and advisories. To remedy this deficiency, the institution must provide a updated catalog with all the required statements, disclosures and advisories that complies with Bureau law and |

| | On August 19, 2021, I reviewed the institution's catalog and found the required statement is not listed as required by CEC/5, CCR. |
