ORDER EXTENDING EFFECTIVE DATE

On February 29, 2024, the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education (Bureau) issued an emergency decision against the University of Antelope Valley (University) directing it to cease enrolling new students, cease instruction, cease collecting tuition

and fees, and cease operating degree programs.

The University timely requested an opportunity to be heard before the Department of

Consumer Affairs, and on March 6, 2024, a hearing was held. On March 8, 2024, the

Department affirmed the Bureau's decision and extended its effective date to March 15,

2024.

On March 14, 2024, the Bureau notified the Department that it was negotiating a

possible settlement of the matter and requested a stay of the emergency decision's

effective date through March 22, 2024.

Good cause therefore appearing, the effective date of the Bureau's emergency

decision is hereby extended. The emergency decision shall take effect March 23, 2024.
