On August 19, 2021, an informal telephone conference was held in the matter of Citation: Assessment of Fine and Order of Abatement No. 2021267 (Citation) against Aziz Abdin, Owner of American University for Human Sciences (Institution). In attendance were Ebony Santee, Licensing Chief, Aziz Abdin, CEO/President, Ousama Alkhwaji, Representative, and Umar Almajid.

Pursuant to Business and Professions Code, section 148; California Education Code (CEC), section 94944; and Title 5 of California Code of Regulations (5, CCR), section 75020 and section 75040, the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education (Bureau) renders the following decision relative to your appeal of the Citation No. 2021267.

It is the decision of the Licensing Chief that on September 20, 2021, Citation No. 2021267 is modified and makes the following change(s):

VIOLATION CODE SECTIONS

#	Below you will find the California Education Code (CEC) and/or Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations (5, CCR code) section(s) of law you are charged with violating.
1.	<p><b><u>Violation:</u></b></p> <p><b>CEC Section 94886. Approval to Operate Required</b> <i>“Except as exempted in Article 4 (commencing with Section 94874) or in compliance with the transition provisions in Article 2 (commencing with Section 94802), a person shall not open, conduct, or do business as a private postsecondary educational institution in this state without obtaining an approval to operate under this chapter.”</i></p> <p><b>CEC Section 94817.5. Approved to Operate or Approved</b> <i>“Approved to operate” or “approved” means that an institution has received authorization pursuant to this chapter to offer to the public and to provide postsecondary educational programs.”</i></p> <p><b>CEC Section 94868. To Offer to the Public</b> <i>“To offer to the public” means to advertise, publicize, solicit, or recruit.”</i></p> <p><b>CEC Section 94869. To Operate</b> <i>“To operate” means to establish, keep, or maintain any facility or location in this state where, or from</i></p>

*which, or through which, postsecondary educational programs are provided.”*

On February 27, 2021, the Bureau received a complaint alleging that the Institution was operating without Bureau approval.

On March 5, 2021, Bureau staff reviewed the Institution’s website and confirmed that the Institution was offering degree programs, found the list of the tuition and fees, and the refund policies for each semester.

The total tuition, based on the number of credits for each program are:

- Bachelors - \$5,400.00
- Masters - \$3,600.00
- Doctorate - \$4,800.00

Between March 8, 2021 and March 31, 2021, Bureau staff attempted to contact the Institution via email, phone, and by mail.

Between April 5, 2021 and April 28, 2021, Bureau staff spoke to the Owner and he stated the Institution is a non-profit organization. In addition, the Owner stated classes were not offered at the Institution’s address; however, the address is used for a mailing address, as all classes are all done online. The Owner stated that the students who take classes at the Institution have graduated from universities. Students enroll at the Institution to continue their education and are awarded a degree or certificate to let them know that they have completed the program and the degree/certificate cannot be used for jobs. The Owner stated that the Institution is not accredited and does not have Bureau approval.

As of June 10, 2021, the Institution offers classes via an online platform at a tuition cost that exceeds \$2,500 which is violation of CEC section 948866, operating without Bureau approval or a valid exemption.

**Order of Abatement:**

The Bureau orders that the Institution cease to operate as a private postsecondary educational institution, unless the Institution qualifies for an exemption under CEC section 94874. The Institution must discontinue recruiting or enrolling students and cease all instructional services and advertising in any form or type of media, including [www.auhs-edu.us](http://www.auhs-edu.us) and [www.auhs-edu.com](http://www.auhs-edu.com), and any other websites not identified here that are associated with the Institution, until such time as an approval to operate is obtained from the Bureau. The Institution must disconnect all telephone service numbers including, but not limited to, (760) 960-1112, that are associated with the Institution until such time as an approval to operate is obtained from the Bureau. To comply with the Order of Abatement the Institution must submit a school closure plan to the Bureau pursuant to California Education Code section 94926. The Institution must provide a roster of each student currently enrolled at the Institution. The roster must include the names of the students, their contact information (including phone number, email address, and physical address), the programs in which they are enrolled, the amount paid for the programs.

	<p><b><u>New Order of Abatement:</u></b> The Institution shall comply with all request of the Order of Abatement in Citation No. 2021267 dated June 15, 2021, except that the phone number (760) 960-1112 can remain in service as it is the owner's phone number.</p> <p><b><u>Assessment of Fine</u></b> The fine for this violation is <u>\$25,000.00</u></p> <p><b><u>Reason for modification:</u></b> New substantive facts were presented at the conference.</p> <p><b><u>The administrative fine for this violation has been modified from \$25,000.00 to \$10,000.00.</u></b></p>

ORDER OF ABATEMENT

**The Bureau orders that you comply with the orders described in the 'Violation Code Sections' of this document and submit evidence of compliance within 30 days from the date of this decision.**

APPEAL OF CITATION

You *do not* have the right to request another Informal Conference to appeal this modified Citation. You *do*, however, have the right to appeal this affirmed or modified Citation through an Administrative Hearing. A hearing before an Administrative Law Judge will be scheduled and you will be notified of the hearing date. The hearing will be held pursuant to Chapter 5 (commencing with section 11500) of Part 1 of Division 3 of Title 2 of the Government Code.

If you do not wish to appeal this modified Citation you must withdraw your initial request for an Administrative Hearing, if one was made. Please complete and mail the enclosed Withdrawal – Request for Administrative Hearing within **30 Days** of the date of this decision.

EFFECTIVE DATE OF CITATION AND FINE ASSESSMENT

This modified Citation is effective on **October 4, 2021**. The Order of Abatement and payment are due by **November 3, 2021**.

Failure to abate the violation or to pay the administrative fine within the time allowed is grounds for denial of an application for an approval to operate or discipline. The Bureau will promptly take all appropriate action to enforce the Modified Citation and recover the civil penalties prescribed therein or found to be due after a hearing.
