On October 1, 2020, an informal telephone conference was held in the matter of Citation: Order of Abatement No. 2021040 (Citation) against John Wesley International Beauty College, Inc., Owner of John Wesley International Barber and Beauty College (Institution). In attendance were Beth Scott, Enforcement Chief and Bonny J. Golz, Financial Aid Director.

Pursuant to Business and Professions Code, section 125.9; California Education Code, section 94936; and Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations, section 75020 and section 75040, the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education (Bureau) renders the following decision relative to your appeal of the Citation No. 2021040.

It is the decision of the Enforcement Chief that on October 20, 2020, Citation No. 2021040 is affirmed for the following reason(s):

- No new substantive facts were presented at the conference.

VIOLATION CODE SECTIONS

#	Below you will find the California Education Code (CEC) and/or Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations (5, CCR code) section(s) of law you are charged with violating.
1.	<p>Violation: 5, CCR Section 74006(a) and (b) - Annual Fee “(a) An institution's annual fee is due within 30 days of the date on which the institution originally receives its approval to operate and each year thereafter on the anniversary of the date of the original approval. (b) An institution shall pay its annual fee in addition to any other applicable fees.</p> <p>CEC Section 94930.5 (g)- Fee Schedule “(g) Notwithstanding subdivision (d), effective July 1, 2018, the annual fee for each campus described in subparagraphs (A) and (B) of paragraph (1) of subdivision (d) shall be in an amount equal to 0.55 percent of that campus’ total gross revenue derived from students in California, but not to be less than two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) and not to exceed sixty thousand</p>



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dollars (\$60,000) for each campus.”

CEC Section 94931(a)– Late Payment

“(a) A fee that is not paid on or before the 30th calendar day after the due date for payment of the fee shall be subject to a 25 percent late payment penalty fee.”

The Institution has failed to pay its 30-day delinquency fee for calendar year 2020.

On March 3, 2020, the Institution was notified, Invoice # 900347915, via mail at, 920 Atlantic Avenue, Suite 200, Long Beach, CA 90813, stating that the annual fee for calendar year 2020 was due on April 1, 2020.

On May 6, 2020, the Bureau received the 2020 annual fee in the amount of \$2,738.18. However, the late payment penalty fee was not included with the fees submitted.

On May 14, 2020, the Institution was notified in letter sent via mail at 920 Atlantic Avenue, Suite 200, Long Beach, CA 90813, that a remaining balance of \$684.55 for the late payment penalty fee was due.

On May 15, 2020, the 1st Delinquency Notice (Invoice # 900347915) was sent via mail at, 920 Atlantic Avenue, Suite 200, Long Beach, CA 90813, stating that the annual fee for calendar year 2020 was due on April 1, 2020.

As of August 27, 2020, the Bureau has not received the 30-day late payment penalty fee from the Institution.

Order of Abatement:

The Bureau orders the Institution to submit its late payment penalty fees in accordance with 5, CCR section 74006(a)(b) and CEC section 94930.5(g).

This affirmed Citation is effective on **October 29, 2020**. The order of abatement is due by **November 28, 2020**.

Failure to abate the violation within the time allowed is grounds for denial of an application for an approval to operate or discipline. The Bureau will promptly take all appropriate action to enforce the Affirmed Citation and recover the civil penalties prescribed therein or found to be due after a hearing.
