Definitions

- "Number of Students Who Began the Program" means the number of students who began a program who were scheduled to complete the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year and excludes all students who cancelled during the cancellation period.
- *"Students Available for Graduation" is the number of students who began the program minus the number of students who have died, been incarcerated, or been called to active military duty.*
- "Number of On-time Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year.
- "On-time Completion Rate" is the number of on-time graduates divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- *"Graduates Available for Employment" means the number of graduates minus the number of graduates unavailable for employment.*
- "Graduates Unavailable for Employment" means the graduates who, after graduation, die, become incarcerated, are called to active military duty, are international students that leave the United States or do not have a visa allowing employment in the United States, or are continuing their education in an accredited or bureau-approved postsecondary institution.
- "Graduates Employed in the Field" means graduates who beginning within six months after a student completes the applicable educational program are gainfully employed, whose employment has been reported, and for whom the institution has documented verification of employment. For occupations for which the state requires passing an examination, the six months period begins after the announcement of the examination results for the first examination available after a student completes an applicable educational program.
- *"Placement Rate Employed in the Field" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates gainfully employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment.*
- "Number of Graduates Taking Exam" is the number of graduates who took the first available exam in the reported calendar year.
- *"First Available Exam Date" is the date for the first available exam after a student completed a program.*
- *"Passage Rate" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates who passed the exam by the number of graduates who took the reported licensing exam.*
- "Number Who Passed First Available Exam" is the number of graduates who took and passed the first available licensing exam after completing the program.
- "Salary" is as reported by graduate or graduate's employer.
- "No Salary Information Reported" is the number of graduates for whom, after making reasonable attempts, the school was not able to obtain salary information.



STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

California Truck Driving Academy's refund policy has been established so that the student or any eligible veteran who cancels the enrollment agreement and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later. (see page 1) To cancel the enrollment agreement you must do the following: Complete, sign and date The Notice to Cancel form is provided to each student upon enrollment and is also found in the Student Catalog and must be sent either via email to enrollment@ctdanow.com, mailed or hand delivered to the Administration office located at 921 North Poinsettia Street, Santa Ana, CA 92701. The Academy Director or Associate Director will sign this notice and mail a copy back to the student with a breakdown of the charges and/or refunds if applicable within 45 days of receipt. [CEC 94911(e)(1)] In the case of students withdrawing after the end of cancellation period, the refund policy for students who have completed 60 percent or less of the period of attendance shall be a pro rata refund. The school will retain a registration fee plus a percentage of tuition and other nonrefundable fees, which is based on the percentage of the clock hours attended, as the examples described in the table below. The institution will pay or credit refunds within 45 days of a student's cancellation or withdrawal.

If the student has received federal student financial aid funds, the student is entitled to a refund of moneys not paid from the federal student financial aid program funds. [CEC 94911(e)(2)]
