Definitions

- "Number of Students Who Began the Program" means the number of students who began a program who were scheduled to complete the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year and excludes all students who cancelled during the cancellation period.
- "Students Available for Graduation" is the number of students who began the program minus the number of students who have died, been incarcerated, or been called to active military duty.
- "Number of On-time Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year.
- "On-time Completion Rate" is the number of on-time graduates divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- "150% Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 150% of the program length (includes on-time graduates).
- "150% Completion Rate" is the number of students who completed the program in the reported calendar year within 150% of the published program length, including on-time graduates, divided by the number of students available for graduation.

Student's right to cancel

- You have the right to cancel this Agreement and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, which is later. Cancellation shall occur when you have given written notice to the Student Services office. You are entitled to a pro-rated refund of non-federal financial aid program monies if you completed 60% or less of the period of attendance.
- Should you voluntarily decline acceptance, fail to complete the terms of admission, withdraw via written notice, or be dismissed from the University for any reason, this agreement will be terminated. All refunds will be made according to the University refund policy which follows.

The student shall have the right to cancel the agreement and receive a full refund pursuant to section 71750 before the first lesson and materials are received.
