## **STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL**

### **CANCELLATION, WITHDRAWAL & REFUND POLICY**

The student has the right to cancel and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later.
